ABOUT ME:

2012 - A goal and dream of winning a national title and representing my country came true, winning the Junior national Time trial championships. I joined Belgian club UCS Crabbe performance for 3 months and gained international experience. I was part of the National team for Road World Championships, a humbling experience for me.

2016 - I found a new motivation in me, really wanting to give it my absolute best and grow as rider with more confidence and ability to focus. I won a couple of races in Cape Town and starting to get results on a national and International level. The highlights was winning the Green jersey in Tour de Reunion and finishing 2nd on the Queen stage of the tour.

2017 - Starting my first full season with my new coach Jeroen Swart made me more excited on my progression from 2016-2017. For the first part of the season my full focus was on going to Belgium for 3 months. I achieved my goals by winning 2 races and placing 8th place in Tour de Province Namur. On my return from Belgium I joined the national team for Tour of Ethiopia, where I had a big role in the team winning the tour overall. I won the last race of the season, a big classic in the region where I live.

2018 - I achieved my early season goal to podium at the National TT championships, then all my focus shifted to getting my condition ready for Belgium. My best result to date in Belgium is a 3rd place in Boutersem a Belgium Cup race. 2018 is a new year and I'm getting stronger and better every time I race. I'm learning something new with every race and I realised it is very important to give myself the opportunity to grow in bigger races.
